ORDER

As per the Government Order read as 2nd & 3rd papers above, the AICTE scales of the teachers of Engineering Colleges have been revised with effect from 1.1.1996. In clause (3- 11) (career advancement) of the said Government Order, the conditions for grant of Placement in Senior Scale / Selection Grade Scale have also been revised as below:

1. All Lecturers who have completed six years of service after regular appointment participated in refresher courses or summer institutes; or similar training programmes of four weeks (Twenty Eight days) duration and have consistently satisfactory appraisal reports will be placed in the Senior Scale.
2. For those who have M.Tech / ME/ M.Phil the period will be five years.
3. For those who have (Ph.D) the period will be four years.
4. All Lecturers (Senior Scale) who have completed five years of service will be placed in Lecturers in Selection Grade Scale.
5. Refresher Course of the same duration is required for placement in the Senior Scale Grade – vide Government letter No. 6444/G1/2002/H.Edn. dated.11.06.2002 and Government Order 3rd cited above.
6. As per the decisions of the screening committee met on 27.03.02, Performance appraisal / students evaluation report for each year of qualifying service duly certified by the Head of Department and Principal are required.
7. If grading is given in the performance appraisal/ students evaluation report 60 % can be considered as satisfactory.

8. The short term courses conducted in Engineering Colleges with assistance of Director of Technical Education and those conducted by the Government organizations like REC,ER & DC, Technopark etc also can be considered for placement, provided the duration is not less than 5 days.
9. The courses attended while working in other AICTE approved Engineering Colleges prior to the entry is to Government Engineering Colleges as Lecturer also can be counted, if such service is being reckoned.
10. As per the G.O, dated.18.05.2000, the period of service as Lecturer in Regional Engineering Colleges, as Lecturer / Assistant Lecturer in Polytechnic in the State after acquiring a degree in Engineering and the experience in a scientific or Industrial Organization under the Government of Kerala or Government of India service and State Government service subject to a maximum of three years provided the Post is compactable (the minimum qualification for the post as same as that of Lecturer in Engineering Colleges). The provisional / contract service of teachers in Engineering Colleges/ Polytechnics will also be counted as qualifying service. As per the decisions of the screening committee met on 27.05.03; the minimum qualification and scale of pay of the post whose Industrial experience is to be reckoned should be comparable to the post of Lecturers in Engineering Colleges.
11. Of the applications for placement in Senior Scale / Selection Grade scale received from the Lecturers of various Engineering colleges, the eligible applications were placed before the screening committee constituted as per Government Order read as first paper, which met on 17.12. 2008 & 19.12.2008. Based on the decisions of the screening committee, the Lecturers as per the list appended to this order (Appendix I) are placed in Senior Scale on Rs. 10,000 – 325 – 15200 and Selection Grade on Rs. 12,000 – 420 – 18300 as shown against each and as on dates noted against them.

The pay of the incumbents on grant of placement in Senior / Selection Grade will be fixed by the Accountant General (A & E).

Statement showing details of qualifying service, qualifications and refresher course etc relating to each incumbent is annexed (Appendix II) to this order.
