PROSPECTUS FOR B.TECH (EVENING) DEGREE ADMISSION- 2023-24

1. Introduction

Evening (Formerly Part-time) Degree Courses are offered in selected Engineering Colleges of the State for students possessing Diploma to acquire Bachelor Degree in Engineering. The course extends over a period of four academic years. The classes will be conducted normally in the evening on all working days and on holidays, if necessary, in accordance with the syllabi of the APJ Abdul Kalam Technological University. The prospectus issued during the previous years is not valid for the year 2023-24.

2. Institutions, Courses and Number of Seats

The list of institutions, courses offered and the total numbers of seats available in each branch are given in **Annexure A**. The course is for 4 years (8 Semesters) duration and will include Lectures, Laboratory works, Seminars, Project work and Thesis. The hours of work will be from 5.45 pm to 9.15 pm, normally 5 days a week.

3. Fee Structure ((5% fee hike will be added as per Govt.Order)

Admission Fee	: Rs. 1050/- to be paid at the time of admission.
Tuition Fee	: Rs. 13130/- per Semester.
Special Fee	: Rs. 3150/- per year.
Caution Deposit	: Rs. 2000/- to be paid at the time of admission (refundable).
Pre-Matriculation & Registration Fee	as prescribed by the University.

Note: Fee concession is not allowed to State & Central Government Employees who belong to the category of SC/ST/OEC//SEBC as per Government letter from SC/ST Department(A), (No.917/A2/2015/SCSTDD, Thiruvananthapuram dated 31/07/2017). However those who are availing leave without allowances (LWA) for higher studies are eligible for fee concession under special conditions as per G.O.(Ms) No. 20/2022/SCTD dated 08/04/2022.

4. Eligibility for Admission

Candidates shall have passed Diploma in Engineering /Technology awarded by the Kerala State Board of Technical Education or equivalent.

At the time of applying for the course, the candidate shall be in employment in

- (i) Government Organizations.
- (ii) Quasi- Government Organizations.
- (iii) Industrial firms duly registered under Co-operative Society's Act.
- (iv) Public or Private Limited companies registered under Companies Act.
- (v) Private-Aided Polytechnics and Private-Aided and un-aided Engineering Colleges in the state.

OR

Self Employed Diploma Holders

Note:- In the absence of eligible candidates with minimum one year after acquiring diploma as on 1st AUGUST 2023, application from those who are having less than one year may also be considered. There will not be any marks for experience awarded to such candidates. A separate rank list will be published for them and the admission from that rank list will be considered only after the admission of professionally eligible candidates.

5. Equivalency of Branches

Candidates will be admitted only to the branch of Engineering in which they have obtained the Diploma. However, certain branches of Diploma are considered equivalent to certain other branches for admission to the B.Tech (Evening) Degree Courses; the details are given in **Annexure B**.

(a) Within the sanctioned seats in each institution, one seat is reserved for candidate under sports quota. Candidates who claim reservation under sports quota must attach a certificate of eligibility issued by the Kerala Sports Council as per the guidelines published by them along with the application for selection under this quota.

(b) 5% seats are reserved for physically disabled. Candidates claiming reservation under physically disabled quota shall have a minimum of 40% disability. A disability certificate from the District Medical Board has to be attached along with the application. Such candidates are also required to produce a certificate obtained from the Medical Officer not below the rank of an Assistant Surgeon to the effect that the candidate is fit enough to undergo the course, having more than 40% disability.

(c) Within the sanctioned strength in each institution, two seats in each branch are reserved for the staff of the Department of Technical Education. Selection will be based on their length of professional service in the Department after acquiring the Diploma. **Such applications must be sent through proper channel of the Directorate of Technical Education, Thiruvananthapuram.**

(d) The seats unavailed by the ST candidates will be allotted to SC candidates and vice versa. The seats unavailed by SC/ST candidates will be allotted to candidates belonging to the Other Eligible Communities.

(e) The seats unavailed in any reservation quota will go to general merit, without prejudice to clause (d) above.

- (f) All candidates from outside Kerala State are considered as General Category and reservation is not applicable.

Note: Keralites: A candidate of Kerala origin will be categorized as a 'Keralite Children' of All India Service (AIS) officers (Non-Keralites) allotted to Kerala cadre are deemed to be 'Keralites' as Per G.O. (Rt) No. 822/08/H. Edn. dated 29/05/2008. But they will not be eligible for Communal/ Special/ Persons with Disabilities or any fee concession.

- (g) As per the G.O.(MS) No.128/2020/ HEDN dated. 20.01.2020. Government has decided to implement reservation for Economically Weaker Sections is general category (EWS) to all Higher Educational Institutions.

7. Claim for the Communal Reservation

- (a) Candidates belonging to SEBC (as per G.O. (P) 208/66/Edn. dated 02/05/1966, G.O. (Ms) No. 95/08/SCSTDD dated 06/10/2008 and as amended from time to time) and whose annual family income (i.e. Annual income of all members in the family, including the candidate, from all sources taken together) is up to **Rs. 8 lakhs (Rupees Eight Lakhs only)** are eligible for reservation under this category (for salaried persons DA should also be taken while computing total income). (G.O(Ms)No.03/2018/BCDD dated 09/04/2018).
- (b) Candidates claiming reservation under SEBC quota should invariably produce Non-creamy layer Certificate obtained issued within one years from the Village Officer concerned
- (c) Candidates claiming reservation under SC/ST quota need to produce Caste/Community Certificates issued within three years from the Tahasildar or front page of SSLC Book showing such details.

8. Application Fees

Applicants can pay the fees online (internet banking/UPI payments/Credit or Debit card transaction) while submitting their applications. Application form number has to be specified for online fee payment. The Fee receipt has to be attached along with the application. Application fees Rs.800/- and Rs.400/- in case of SC/ST Candidates.

9. Submission of Applications

The time schedule is given in **Annexure C**.

The documents to be uploaded include:

- (a) Diploma Certificate.
- (b) Mark List of Diploma Examination. In the case of semester system, the mark lists of all semesters should be attached. The copy of Diploma Mark List must contain both sides of the original Mark List.
- (c) Non Creamy Layer Certificate for SEBC Candidates issued within one year from the Village Officer concerned and Community Certificate for SC/ST candidates issued within three years from the Tahasildar or front page of SSLC Book showing such details
- (d) Those who claim experience as per clause 4, (i) to (v) and 6(c), a **copy of the Experience Certificate as per Annexure E duly attested by the Head of the Establishment should be attached** and Self Employed Diploma Holders should produce a **self declaration Form as per Annexure F**.

- (e) Application defective in any respect or which do not contain the relevant document or those received late will summararily be rejected.

Note : *No opportunity will be given to incorporate any details after the submission of the application.*

10. Selection

- (a) Selection of candidates will be made by the Director, Directorate of Technical Education, Thiruvananthapuram.
- (b) A branch wise rank list and short list based on an index mark will be prepared and published at the website:
www.dtekerala.gov.in
- (c) The index mark is calculated as the sum of the aggregate percentage of marks obtained in all the semesters/years in the Diploma Examination and marks for the period after acquiring diploma calculated as 2 marks per year. Maximum marks awarded towards experience will be limited to 10. *The date of issue of final year/ final semester mark list will be considered for counting the qualifying experience.*
- (d) In the case of tie in the index marks, the age of the candidate will be taken into account and the older will be placed higher in the ranking.

11. Allotment to the Institution

- (a) Allotment to Institution will be done based on the rank. The rank list will be published on the websites www.dtekerala.gov.in .
- (b) If a candidate is not joining in an Institution as per the allotment, his further claim for admission will be automatically cancelled.
- (c) Selected candidates shall produce a No Objection Certificate from the Head of the office / Establishment in the format given in **Annexure D** at the time of joining.
12. The admission work is entrusted to the Directorate of Technical Education, East Fort, Thiruvananthapuram.

13. Cancellation of Courses

- (a) If the number of eligible candidates opted for any branch in an institution is less than 60% of the sanctioned intake, the course will not be conducted at that institution.
- (b) Any other details not specifically covered by the clauses given will be decided by the Director of Technical Education and his decision will be final.
- (c) Any admission found to be not in order subsequent to the admission will be liable for cancellation.
